MODERNFOLD TRUSS SYSTEM TECHNICAL DATA

PART 1 – GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

- A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division 01 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

1.2 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes the following:
1. Manually operated, individual panel operable partitions.
 2. Manually operated, individual glass panel partitions.
- B. Related Sections include the following:
1. Division 03 Sections for concrete tolerances required.

1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Installer Qualifications: An experienced installer who is certified in writing by the glass operable partition manufacturer, as qualified to install the manufacturer's partition systems for work similar in material, design, and extent to that indicated for this Project.
- B. The Modernfold Truss System shall be validated by calculations performed by a licensed Professional Engineer registered to practice in the state where the truss system will be installed. Written documentation and/or report must be provided specific to this Project.
- C. Preparation of the opening shall conform to the criteria set forth per ASTM E557 "Standard Practice for Architectural Application and Installation of Operable Partitions."

1.4 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Material descriptions, construction details, and installation details for the truss system, components, and accessory specified.
- B. Shop Drawings: Show location and extent of truss system. Include plans, elevations, sections, and details. Indicate dimensions, weights, conditions at openings and at storage areas. Indicate location and installation requirements for hardware and track.

1.5 DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- A. Protect Modernfold Truss System during delivery, storage, and handling to comply with manufacturer's direction and as required to prevent damage.

1.6 WARRANTY

- A. Provide written warranty by manufacturer of truss system agreeing to repair or replace any components with manufacturing defects.
- B. Warranty period: Two (2) years.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MANUFACTURERS, PRODUCTS, AND OPERATION

- A. Manufacturers: Subject to compliance with requirements, provide products by one of the following:
1. Modernfold, Inc.
- B. Products: Subject to compliance with the requirements, provide one of the following products:
1. Modernfold Truss System.

2.2 MATERIALS

- A. Components
1. Truss components shall be factory fabricated of steel; aluminum components are not acceptable. Modernfold Truss System is attached to the building structure for lateral support only. The load of the truss and partition is supported by the column support tubes.
 2. Base End Tube and I-Beam Sections. Bolt together truss has steel

tube and steel I-beam sections with integral track attachments points. Aluminum truss, tube, and/or I-beam components are not acceptable.

3. Column Support Tubes. Column support tubes shall be 3" x 3" (76 mm x 76 mm) steel tubing; aluminum components are not acceptable. Column support tubes shall be attached to the truss with steel brackets and bolts. Column support tubes shall be anchored to the floor with concealed fasteners utilizing a base plate limits the direct load on the floor to 575 psi maximum.
 4. Truss bracing provides operational stability to the Modernfold Truss System and shall be set at each column support tube and centered in each I-beam section. Blocking for truss bracing to be provided by others in accordance with the plans.
- B. Modernfold Truss System as manufactured by Modernfold, Inc.
1. The truss is to be shipped in sections and assembled on site for custom assembly which meets site conditions. Maximum weight of any component should not exceed 300 pounds. Pre-assembled truss systems are not acceptable.
- C. Options and Accessories
1. Column Cover. Designed to cover Column Support Tube when not installed within finished wall. Column Covers are finished to match partition finish (select finish).
 - a. Vinyl covering. Color to be selected from Modernfold's standard offering.
 - b. Fabric covering. Color to be selected from Modernfold's standard offering.
 - c. Carpet covering. Color to be selected from Modernfold's standard offering.
 - d. Uncovered for field painting.
 - e. Cloth backed real wood veneer. Color to be selected from Modernfold's standard offering.
 2. Base plate. Optional Base Plate for each Column Support Tube limits the direct load on the floor to 350 psi maximum. (Standard plate limits the direct load on the floor to 575 psi maximum.)

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. General: Comply with ASTM E557, operable partition manufacturer's written installation instructions and approved shop drawings.
- B. Assemble and install Modernfold Truss System on site for custom assembly which meets site conditions. Adjust Column Support Tubes and Base End Tube Assemblies to meet requirements specific to this project.
- C. The complete installation of the Modernfold Truss System shall be by a certified factory-trained installer in strict accordance with the approved shop drawings and manufacturer's standard printed specifications, instructions, and recommendations.

3.2 CLEANING AND PROTECTION


- A. Clean component surfaces upon completing installation of truss system to remove dust, dirt, and other foreign materials according to manufacturer's written instructions.

3.3 EXAMINATION


- A. Examine flooring, Modernfold Truss System, and opening, with Installer present, for compliance with requirements for installation tolerances and other conditions affecting performance of operable partitions. Proceed with installation of operable partitions only after unsatisfactory conditions have been corrected.


#17 TRACK SYSTEM BRACKET MOUNT




G-330 TRACK SYSTEM BRACKET MOUNT
