SUMMARY

The Master Scheduler evaluates plant capacity requirements and ensures maximum usage of capacity to satisfy customer requirements. The position acts as a liaison with a variety of departments both up and down stream to ensure the proper information flow, resulting in maximizing capacity and ensuring on-time delivery to our customers.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Creates and releases work orders/production schedules for Manufacturing as required to ensure on-time delivery to customers.
- Develops the overall master schedule in a way that prioritizes manufacturing operations based on customer need and operation efficiencies. Optimize use of MRP(TCM) system for increased efficiency across multiple levels of organization.
- Responsible for generating capacity-feasible production plans. Identify overtime needs or capacity change requirements. Analyze and evaluate production schedule alternatives and recommend adjustments when needed.
- Responsible for rescheduling including internal customer communication to fill capacity, resequencing of capacity as needed, large project coordination and sequencing. Manage shop orders to balance work.
- Manage change activity at the work order level and work with manufacturing to ensure timely and accurate material management/reporting practices and procedures.
- Proactively review material supply and demand to determine push/pull actions appropriate to impact manufacturing. Manage these exceptions to minimize production/customer impact.
- Monitor/report on Manufacturing attainment to the production plan and expedite as required and communicate on-time delivery issues to Customer Service as issues arise.
- Coordinate with purchasing, production, engineering, quality, and sales to achieve customer required delivery dates.
- Assess impact to materials availability and production schedule. Communicate changes from planned dates or intervene to ensure delivery dates.
- Drive, promote and develop positive communication with Sales to improve forecast accuracy.

- Provides regular and proactive input to the associated function leaders in the areas of capacity planning, surge capacity needs and consumption, forecasting accuracy and cost savings opportunities related to production scheduling.
- Improve forecasting tools and procedures through application of innovative ideas.
- Assists with special projects (i.e., new product/customer ramp-up plans).
