ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain project schedules and milestone reporting.
- Lead Major Project weekly review meetings.
- Work with Engineering and Sales to document project scope and layout.
- Ensure Finance has the correct bill of materials.
- Complete and submit order forms on Modernfold owned jobs.
- Review and approve acknowledgements.
- Coordinate long lead time materials with factory and purchasing.
- Review contract documents and note and special items.
- Coordinate changes with all affected departments.
- Project approval submittals (get approval from customer prior to starting work)
- Verify facility is on schedule.
- Verify facility is ready prior to installation start dates.
- Attend on site project meetings as needed.
- Write Trouble Reports.
- Develop plan to repair damaged or non-functioning product.
- Coordinate development of punch list.
- Coordinate fix of punch list items.
- Obtain project sign off with GC on Modernfold owned projects.
- Organize and conduct owners training with local distributor on Modernfold owned projects.
- Other duties as assigned by the Engineering and Purchasing Director
